Workshops are for a maximum of 7 students (dependent on project). If a workshop is oversubscribed, a waiting list will be set up and additional dates offered. PLEASE NOTE: Some workshops are only available on a Thursday. If you would prefer a Saturday please ask and if there is enough interest, we will arrange new dates.

Small but mighty, On the Go 2.0 is the perfect compact bag for travel or everyday use. Designed with multiple pockets and a secure zipper closure, it keeps your essentials organized and easily accessible. The adjustable, detachable strap lets you wear it over the shoulder or as a crossbody bag, offering versatility and comfort. This bag can be customised to your needs.

Finished Size: 8"H x 6"W x 2"D

Quilted Jacket - £35 per session (4 sessions) + £16 for discounted pattern

Thursday 29th January; 26th February; 19th March; 9th April OR

Saturday 24th January; 28th February; 28th March; 25th April – 10am=3pm

There will be a choice of two patterns, the Hovea by Megan Neilsen or the Tamarack from Grainline Studios.

The Hovea is a patchwork jacket in three lengths and has a v-neck and large pockets. I made the sample from a jelly roll and a co-ordinating fabric. I also used a small clasp fastening.

The Tamarack is made from one outer fabric but has a choice of a round neck, collar or hood and patch or welt pockets. I made the sample using an ombre fabric, welt pockets and a hood. Snap fasteners completed the look.

NOTE: When you book, the requirements list will give you pattern sizes. I will need to know at least 7 working days before the first class which size pattern you need. (These are not the same as ready to wear sizes in the shops). Details on the requirements list.

Patch the Dog Pincushion and Caddy - £35

Saturday 14th February OR Thursday 12th March – 10am – 3pm

This cute little dog will brighten up your sewing room and is a useful pincushion. There is felt under the ears for hand sewing needles, and he wears a saddle with a pocket for small items on one side and a strap for holding clips on the other. His body can be made with pieced panels (as in my sample) or with one main fabric.

Finished size: 16" wide x 8 ½" high x 3" deep

Thursday 19th February OR Saturday 14th March - 10am-3pm

Zippered pouches in five sizes are perfect for storing and carrying makeup, sewing supplies, and more.

Double-slide zippers and handy grab tabs make the bags easy to open wide; attached side panels prevent contents from falling out. An optional strap with swivel hook may be added. When empty, the bags nest to save space.

We will make the large size in this class.
